- A late registration fee of R2000 will automatically be charged to the account of any student who registers late. Waiver of
 the fee will be considered by the Dean only in the most exceptional of circumstances which must be fully motivated in
 writing.
- Students must bring printouts of their academic record and completed hard copy registration forms to in-person registration sessions.
- All new International and SADC students must get fee clearance, present their study permits and health insurance details the day before they are scheduled to register at the IAPO office, Masingene Building, Middle Campus;

Important Notices

- Curriculum Advice This will take place in-person at venues to be advised. After obtaining advice you will need to upload your curriculum form into Peoplesoft as a service request. Please consult the tables below for the advising and submission dates. It is very important that you check your UCT email account for updates during January and February and ensure that you start obtaining your advice EARLY in the advising date range, even if the final date for submission of forms is later. You should also aim to upload your forms near the start of the submission date range to ensure that your form is captured before the start of term. First year students should get their UCT email account set up well in advance of registration, to ensure that they receive the important information they will need for orientation and registration.
- Orientation starts on 23 January for local students, and 30th January for out-of-town students (residences open 29th January)
- Data Capturing: Fine Art and Theatre and Dance 1st year students and Social Work and PP 1st year and returning students will register via "Programme Enrolment". A "task" will be sent to you once you are made active for the year, and you will enrol yourself by following a set of steps and making your selection from a pre-set list of courses. For all other programmes students will complete an activity guide online to provide registration information, and will then complete and submit a curriculum form (after obtaining advice if needed) and upload it via a "Service Request" to Peoplesoft, where it will be checked and the data will be captured. Incomplete, unsigned or incorrect forms will be rejected and students will be notified to re-submit a complete and correct form.
- International and SADC students: All new and returning international and SADC students must report to the International Academic Programmes Office (IAPO) via prereg@uct.ac.za and obtain pre-registration clearance by presenting their proof of payment of fees, passport, study visa and proof of medical insurance prior to registering.
- Outstanding Fees: Students with fee debts cannot be registered, and they should liaise with the Fees Office regarding clearance of debt prior to registration. The Fees Office can be contacted on fnd-feeeng@uct.ac.za.
- Late registration: A late registration fee of R2000 will automatically be charged to your fee account if you register after the dates specified below. Only the Dean can waive the late registration penalty and only in exceptional circumstances which must be fully motivated in writing.
- Initial fee payments: An initial fee payment is required by Friday, 3 February 2023. If payment is not received on or before the due date, a late payment fee of 10% of the unpaid amount will be charged.
