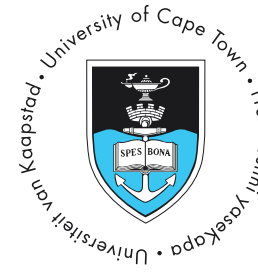


UCT-OIC SEXUAL MISCONDUCT SAFETY PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

- UCT NO CONTACT ORDER
- UCT SUSPENSION ORDER

Debriefing and Counselling Support is prioritised throughout the UCT Processes as requested by the Survivor



i These UCT Orders do not prevent the respondent from continuing with their Academic progress and responsibilities



COUNSELLING CONSULTATION: Discussion of UCT Orders with the Survivor
Support Specialist: Case Officer



Decision: Survivor confirms decision through email



REQUEST FOR UCT ORDER: Case report referred to the Specialised Tribunal of Sexual Offences



APPLICATION OF UCT ORDER: Specialised Tribunal presents the request to the UCT Proctor



PROCTOR'S DECISION: consideration of interim UCT Order



INTERIM UCT ORDER GRANTED: Credible allegations, respondent informed of interim order and receives survivor's statement



INTERIM UCT ORDER DECLINED: Criteria for provision of UCT Order not met (eg: recent contact; level of threat)



INTERIM UCT ORDER GRANTED: Respondent attends hearing with the Specialised Tribunal and UCT Proctor within 72hrs
Survivor is not present at the hearing



OUTCOME OF UCT ORDER



FINAL UCT ORDER GRANTED:



INTERIM UCT ORDER DECLINED:



FEEDBACK ON OUTCOME: Specialised Tribunal informs Survivor of the outcome of the UCT Order
Survivor and Respondent receives a copy of the Final Order



OIC ENGAGEMENT



SURVIVOR SUPPORT SPECIALIST: Case Office refers and engages with the survivor, and appropriate stakeholders for case Specific accommodations



RESPONDENT MANAGEMENT: Relations strategist refers and engages with the respondent, and appropriate stakeholders for the implementation rulings of the UCT Order
