Lead applicant must:

- Be a researcher within the social sciences or the humanities.
- Hold a PhD (or have equivalent research experience).

At least one co-applicant must be based in the UK.

## Award Details:

- Awards of up to £200,000 are available for projects with a duration of up to 18 months.
- The Academy supports projects that deliver clear insights and actionable outcomes at local, national, or regional levels in eligible countries.

**Application Process:**

Applications must be submitted online using the British Academy's Grant Management System (GMS), [Flexi-Grant®](#).

This call involves a single-stage application process. Applications, along with host organisation approval, must be submitted by **10 April 2025**. Institutional approval via UCT's electronic Research Administration ([eRA](#)) system is required before submission.
