APPLICATIONS for 2022 OPEN on 1 July 2021

A limited number of scholarships are available to graduates who are not South African. These are awarded on a competitive basis and preference is given to senior candidates. Applications are to be made the preceding year.

- All UCT International and Refugee Students' Scholarships are supplementary.
- Students who apply must have the means to fund their studies.
- The scholarships are renewable for the duration of the course of study, if satisfactory progress is maintained, for one year at honours level, two at master's level and three at doctoral level.
- Applicants must apply for full-time admission through the UCT Admissions Office or the Faculty Office. Late applications are not accepted.

NOTE: No late and/or incomplete applications will be accepted and will be disqualified.
