2 Financial need

Demonstrate financial need, assessed on the basis of total annual household income:

- Up to R350,000: eligible for a full (100%) scholarship
- R350,001 – R800,000: eligible for a partial (75%) scholarship

3 Academic

Have a strong academic record, with a minimum average of 70% or equivalent.

*Applications are open to international candidates, with priority given to applicants from South Africa.

Undergraduate and PhD studies are not included in this scholarship.
