TO UCT GRADUATES AND HOLDERS OF DIPLOMAS AND CERTIFICATES

Invitation to nominate persons for election as members of the electoral college to elect the Chancellor of the University of Cape Town

The term of office of the current Chancellor, Graça Machel, will end in 2019. A call for nominations for appointment as Chancellor was published on 9 May 2019.

In terms of the UCT's Institutional Statute, the Chancellor is elected by an electoral college which consists of

- a. the president of Convocation
- b. twenty-one members elected by UCT graduates, and holders of diplomas and certificates, from their number
- c. six members elected by the academic staff from their number
- d. six members elected by the professional, administrative support and service staff from their number
- e. six students elected by the Students' Representative Council

UCT graduates and holders of diplomas and certificates are invited to nominate candidates for the electoral college in category (b) above.

Each nomination for the electoral college must be in writing and must

- a. be signed by six people, each of whom must be a UCT graduate or the holder of a diploma or certificate
- b. be accompanied by the nominee's written acceptance of his or her nomination and by a statement by him or her, not exceeding 200 words, summarising his or her curriculum vitae.

If more than 21 nominations are received, an electronic ballot will follow.
