

ERRATUM TO THE STUDENT FEES HANDBOOK 2021

Section 2 amendments: The following amendments corrects dates as per sections below due to a delay in the 2021 academic start of term;

2.2 Notice to Leave: Withdrawal of Registration

A registered student (or legal guardian) is personally liable for all tuition fees notwithstanding any pledges of support or bursary that they may have received.

Students or their legal guardians must give notice of intention to discontinue studies in writing by completing the Cancellation of Registration Form and submitting this together with their student card to their Faculty Office in person **or by registered mail**.

A R500 Administration Fee will be charged on all cancellations / withdrawals. International students, including those from SADC countries, refer to Section 5.8.3

A reduction on the academic fees may be considered in special circumstances, depending on **when the notice of intention to discontinue studies is received by the Faculty Office**. If notice is received before:

(a) **Whole Year Courses starting in March:**

29 March 2021.....100% adjustment
06 August 2021.....50% adjustment

(b) **First Semester Courses starting in February:**

29 March 2021..... 100% adjustment
02 April 2021..... 50% adjustment

(c) **Second Semester Courses starting in July:**

06 August 2021..... 100% adjustment
20 August 2021..... 50% adjustment

(d) **Full year programme starting in second semester**

06 August 2021..... 100% adjustment
18 February 2022..... 50% adjustment

No reduction will be granted if the notice of intention to discontinue studies is received after the above deadlines.

Note: These dates will be strictly adhered to. *Any fees owing is due immediately on cancellation of studies.*

2.3 Drop an Individual Course

When students withdraw from individual courses of a minimum duration of one semester, any fee reduction is dependent upon the date of withdrawal. If the course duration is less than one semester, there is no fee reduction if a student withdraws from the course after it begins.

No reduction will be granted if the notice to withdraw is received after the above deadlines.

After the last date to withdraw from a course but before the tenth last teaching day of a semester or year course, a student may notify the faculty office that he or she does not intend to complete the course. In this case the course remains on the record with a result of INC. During the last ten days of a semester or year course such notifications will no longer be accepted and a result of DPR or AB will be awarded by the department.

No withdrawal is possible after the 'cancel transcript' entry date.

2.7 Leave of Absence

A student who is granted a prospective academic concession for Leave of Absence will be entitled to a fee rebate depending on the date and period for which the Leave of Absence is granted. Refer Rule G.16.

If Leave of Absence is granted before the following date for the remainder of the academic year:

- (a) Whole Year Courses starting in March
 - 29 March 2021 100% adjustment
 - 30 April 2021 75% adjustment
 - 06 August 2021 50% adjustment
 - 17 September 2021 25% adjustment

- (b) First Semester Courses starting in March
 - 19 March 2021 100% adjustment
 - 02 April 2021 50% adjustment

- (c) Second Semester Courses starting in August
 - 06 August 2021 100% adjustment
 - 20 August 2021 50% adjustment

- (e) Block Course refer to section 2.3

These dates will be strictly adhered to. No further concessions will be granted if Leave of Absence is granted after the above deadlines.

Students are required to pay the minimum prescribed academic fees prior to graduation.

5. INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

5.8 International Fees Cancellation Policy

5.8.1 Semester/Study Abroad Programme

A US\$ 100 administration fee may be applied to cancellations received after a student indicates acceptance but prior to arrival.

A US\$ 220 administration fee may be applied to all cancellations received after a student arrives but before registration.

A 50% fee rebate of the Semester Study Abroad package tuition fee will be applied to cancellations or withdrawals by 14 February 19 March for Semester 1 intakes and 17 July 06 August for Semester 2 intakes. There will be no fee rebate for any cancellation or withdrawal thereafter.

Notice of intention to withdraw must be made in writing to the International Office on or before the deadline. No reduction will be granted if the notice of intention to withdraw is received after the deadline.

5.8.2 International Occasional Students

A 50% fee rebate of the course fee will be applied to withdrawal from a semester course by 14 February 19 March for Semester 1 intakes and 17 July 06 August for Semester 2 intakes. There will be no fee rebate for any cancellation or withdrawal thereafter.

Notice of intention to withdraw must be made in writing to the International Office on or before the deadline. No reduction will be granted if the notice of intention to withdraw is received after the deadline.

There will be no rebate for withdrawal from a summer term or winter term course.

5.8.3 Full Degree Students (GSB students refer to Section 2.2.1)

The policy and associated rebates for withdrawal of registration or cancellation of a course can be found at sections 2.2 and 2.3 respectively of this handbook.

Students or their parents or guardians must give notice to discontinue studies in writing by completing the Cancellation of Registration Form and submitting this to their Faculty Office in person or by registered mail.

A reduction on the International Term Fee will be considered if registration is cancelled before:

(a) the beginning of the first quarter, 10 February 15 March 2021..... 100% adjustment
before 13 July 02 August 2021 50% adjustment

Students registering for the first time in the second semester who cancel/withdraw before:

(b) the beginning of the third quarter, 13 July 02 August 2021 100% adjustment
after 13 July 02 August 2021..... No adjustment

No reduction of the International Term Fee will be granted if registration is cancelled after the 13 July 02 August 2021.

Note: The International/SADC Administrative Fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

Any outstanding fees are due immediately upon cancellation of studies. For fee rebates for dropping or changing course enrolments, refer to section 2.3.
