



## LECTURER: CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

We invite applications for this 4-year contract, part-time (20 hour per week) Lecturer position within the Division of Psychotherapy in the Department of Psychiatry and Mental Health, Faculty of Health Sciences. This post is funded by the Department of Education. The funding has been granted for the purposes of the training and teaching of undergraduate students in the Faculty of Health.

Operationally the mission of the Division is translated into the following objectives:

- To provide teaching and training in evidence-based practice and training in psychotherapy to students within the faculty of health science.
- To develop and increase the psychotherapy expertise and capacity.
- To develop research expertise in psychotherapy practice, teaching and training with global evidence-based models to address the local needs of patients in South Africa.
- To develop short courses in psychotherapy to allocate psychotherapy cases and provide supervision to registrars and members of the department.

The main purpose of this post is thus the provision of teaching, training and education in psychological skills and knowledge to students and associated activities in the Faculty of Health Sciences in line with the objective of the Division of Psychotherapy

The aim of the Division is to integrate core skills and competencies of psychotherapy assessment, and evidence-based psychotherapeutic interventions and treatment into identified student cohorts (classes), academic curriculum, who receive training and teaching in the Department of Psychiatry and Mental Health at the University of Cape Town.

### Requirements:

- Masters Degree in Clinical Psychology
- Registration with the HPCSA as a clinical psychologist.
- 1 year's post registration experience (including community service).
- Teaching, academic and research experience will be advantageous.

### Responsibilities:

- Teaching, training, academic supervision, clinical supervision/peer mentoring and examination of medical students.
- Curriculum development, monitoring and evaluation.
- Design and conduct research.
- Represent the Department and Division at Departmental and Faculty committees.
- Liaise with appropriate divisions within the department.

The annual remuneration package, including benefits, is between R382 827 and R512 225.
