The Department of Psychology at the University of Cape Town is seeking to employ an Assistant Lecturer, specialising in pediatric neuropsychology, starting as soon as possible in 2023. The Department is committed to appointing a candidate from an under-represented designated group, in line with the University's Employment Equity Plan.

Requirements:

- MA thesis research topic falling within the broadly-defined areas of neuropsychology or cognitive neuroscience
- Demonstrable investment in the pursuit of PhD scholarship in Psychology (a minimum requirement is registration for that degree before the end of 2023)
- Current registration, or eligibility for registration within the next 12 months, with the Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA) as an independent practitioner in the category of Neuropsychology
- Teaching or tutoring experience in neuropsychology and/or cognitive neuroscience

Responsibilities:

- Clinical supervision of Master's in Neuropsychology students, and Neuropsychology interns, seeing pediatric cases at Red Cross War Memorial Hospital
- Teaching, as assigned, throughout undergraduate and postgraduate years (particularly that involving neuropsychology / cognitive neuroscience at the undergraduate level)
- Conduct and publish research
- Contribute to departmental administration

Advantageous:

- Doctoral degree in Psychology
- A research track record (especially in neuropsychology and/or cognitive neuroscience) as evidenced by peer-reviewed publications in reputable journals
- Evidence of successful teaching and supervision of postgraduate theses
- Experience in clinical supervision of neuropsychology cases
- Fluency at conversational level in Afrikaans and/or isiXhosa
