Experience in the use of spatial analysis techniques and tools would be advantageous. Some teaching experience at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels are essential. The successful candidate will be expected to teach at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels, supervise postgraduate research, sustain their own research and publication focus while also taking up administrative portfolios in the department. There would also be opportunities to engage and work alongside research units associated with EGS.
