The Centre for Infectious Diseases Research in Africa (CIDRI-Africa) based at the Institute of Infectious Disease and Molecular Medicine (IDM) in the Faculty of Health Sciences invites applications from suitably experienced candidates for a 12-month contract position as a Research Nurse on the clinical Research Site at Khayelitsha Site B and the Khayelitsha District Hospital.

These sites conduct multiple clinical trials and observational studies. The incumbent will be based at the Khayelitsha Site B (eKhayavac) and will support the in-patient study at Khayelitsha District Hospital. The main purpose of this position is to carry out nursing duties at selected facilities in Cape Town as part of ongoing research projects conducted at those facilities.

Minimum Requirements:

- General Diploma or Degree in Nursing
- SANC registration as a Professional/Registered Nurse
- 2 years general nursing experience, post community service
- Previous experience working with HIV and Tuberculosis (TB)patients
- Advanced experience in phlebotomy
- Computer literacy
- Knowledge on GCP reflected in application

- Previous experience in in-patient studies
- Demonstrable leadership ability reflected in CV
- Good Clinical Practice Certificate

- Performing clinical procedures such as phlebotomy
- Performing screening for studies in hospital wards with TB participants
- Assisting with pharmacokinetic study sampling
- Obtaining informed consent from participants and next of kin
- Administering study medication and documentation of administration
- Liaise with study pharmacist regarding study drug administration as needed.
- Capturing data directly on to electronic database
- Completing and performing quality control of case report forms (CRFs)
- Liaise with existing research team regarding study protocols
- · Working within a dynamic research team
