The Desmond Tutu HIV Centre (DTHC), based in the Faculty of Health Sciences, is committed to the pursuit of excellence in research, treatment, training and prevention of HIV and related infections in Southern Africa.

This full-time 24 month fixed-term contract position will be based at Emavundleni Research Centre, Lower Crossroads, Cape Town. The main purpose of this position is to be a line manager for the nurses and to coordinate the supply of nursing services to the two locations that make up the DTHC Clinical Research Site. The Research Nurse Coordinator functions under the supervision of the Site Clinical Operations Lead (for operational aspects) with input from the on-site research medical officers (when necessary to coordinate the provision of nursing staff to implement the prescribed clinical care plans compiled by the medical officers). The Research Nurse Coordinator is responsible for all on-site coordination of nursing activities for multiple clinical trials across both locations. The role includes general study administration, staff supervision and training with the scientific and clinical guidance from the PI, as well as information to study participants.

### **Minimum Requirements:**

- Senior Certificate (Grade 12)
- Qualification as Professional / Registered Nurse (or equivalent experience)
- Registration with the South African Nursing Council (SANC) or HPCSA
- At least 4 years' experience as nurse in clinical trials
- At least 2 years' experience in a leadership role in clinical trials
- Fluency in English (in addition, Xhosa fluency would be a substantial advantage)
- Valid Driver's License
- Good decision making and prioritising skills
- Good interpersonal and communication skills
- · Attention to detail
- Excellent Computer Literacy (MS Office)
- Understanding of regulatory requirements for clinical trial implementation
