The Marine Biogeochemistry Lab at the University of Cape Town (UCT-MBL) is a world-class oceanic and atmospheric biogeochemistry laboratory established to address large- and small-scale research questions in Earth Science, particularly those that leverage South Africa's geographic advantage. The laboratory is equipped with cutting-edge infrastructure, much of it unique on the African continent, that is available to support high-quality, high-visibility, and high-impact research and to train the next generation of South African Earth scientists. The UCT-MBL is part of the Isotope and Atmosphere nodes of the Biogeochemistry Research Infrastructure Platform (BIOGRIP), and this position is partially supported by BIOGRIP.

The successful candidate will take responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the denitrifier-isotope ratio mass spectrometry (denitrifier-IRMS) facility in the Marine Biogeochemistry Laboratory. This includes the maintenance and repair of the IRMS instrumentation and the custom-built gas-bench, as well as ensuring a well-maintained facility. They will also be involved in liaising with outside users of the facility and overseeing day-to-day isotope sample preparation and analyses.
