Note :

1. The full-time equivalent data used to generate these tables was extracted from the HEMIS Sub 3 course registration tables for each year.
2. A full-time equivalent (FTE) student enrolment for a course at the undergraduate level is determined by multiplying its head count enrolment by the fraction it constitutes of a standard full-time curriculum. For example, if course X which has a head count enrolment of 400 is taken standardly with 3 others, then its FTE total would be $0.25 \times 400 = 100$. Undergraduate courses taken at level 400 carry a weighting of 2.
3. FTE calculations at the postgraduate level initially involve the calculation of credit values, derived from the average time taken by successful candidates to complete their degrees. Weighted FTE enrolments are then calculated by multiplying head count enrolments by the appropriate credit value, applying a weighting factor of 2 at the honours level, 3 at the masters level or 4 at the doctoral level.
4. A faculty's weighted FTE student total is the sum of the weighted FTE totals of all courses offered by its constituent departments.
5. A faculty which fulfills a substantial service role to other faculties will have a weighted FTE total which is higher than its head count total.
