1-2 YEARS REQUIREMENTS LIST



- 2 x face cloths
- 2 x complete sets of clothing (other than what your child is wearing);
- 5 x disposables per day;
- 2 x cot size sheets (to fit standard cot: 660 ;1320 mm);
- 2 x blankets (1 for summer and 1 for winter: these will be sent home for washing);
- Wet wipes to be replenished;
- 1 x box of 200 tissues per box (**per term**);
- 1 x box of 100 powder-free medium latex gloves (**per term**): to be used for every nappy change;
- Cream in tube (**NOT in container**) to apply when changing disposables;
- 1 x pack of colour cardboard, preferably A3 size
- 1 x pack of (A3 size) colour paper
- 4 x ID size photos;
- R300.00** fundraising levy (once-off payment);

Teething powder, wet wipes and buttocks cream / powder of your choice. These items will be kept in your child's locker. Please replenish when depleted.

- Suntan lotion (SPF 20 or higher) and a cap/hat clearly marked;
- 1x over-sized t-shirt to wear as protective gear when work in the art area (painting)
- 1x over-sized t-shirt to wear during "water play" and to protect the child against sunburn;
- 1 spare sterilized bottle to be kept at the Centre;
- A plastic packet in the bag daily for soiled clothes;
- 1 x flip file (30 pages) for portfolio (**new learners only**);

Please keep us informed of the following:

- Your child's diet and feed formula - specify exclusions from your child's diet (if due to sensitivities, allergies or personal preference).
- When you suspect that your child is teething or experiencing any discomfort or if your child is sick, please inform the class teacher as soon as possible.

It would be helpful if you could comply with the following:

- Supply a well-balanced meal (provide all food and drink requirements for your child ready for consumption - food can be heated);
- No sweets, cakes, chips or fizzy drinks.
- Please ensure that all bottle caps, container lids and containers are clearly marked with your child's name.**
- Please provide sealed containers and bottles with caps to prevent cross-contamination.
