Dr Tshepo Mosaka is a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Public Law. He specialises in the Law of Evidence, Legal Coloniality and Criminal Jurisprudence. Mosaka holds an LLB (with distinction) from Wits University, an LLM (with distinction) from the University of Cape Town (UCT) and a PhD from the University of Nottingham. Since joining UCT in July 2020, Mosaka has published 11 peer-reviewed articles – all within 18 months – earning him a Research Incentive award as an active researcher in the Faculty of Law. Mosaka’s doctoral research focused on the evidential proof of witchcraft in Africa, and he currently teaches the Law of Evidence and Criminal law. His first book (co-authored with Pamela-Jane Schwikkard), *Principles of Evidence* 5th ed (Juta), will be released in January 2023. Before joining UCT, Mosaka also attained professional experience doing his articles of clerkship at ENSAfrica (Johannesburg office). Prior to joining the world of academia, Mosaka used to don the number 11 shirt for three seasons as a football player for the Bidvest Wits Football Club academy.
