Credit System/Transfer

Grades are awarded at the end of the semester for individual courses and usually based on the final examination as well as continuous assessment through the semester (assignments, tutorials and tests). Usual Work Load

Students should take between 72 and 90 credits per semester to be considered as having a "full academic load". This is equivalent to the credits typically earned by a degree-seeking student in a semester.
