New students first attend Orientation and obtain advice in-person to help decide on their curriculum and majors before they enrol by submitting their registration task. Returning students who do not need advice can register online from 8 January.

New and returning students who need in-person advice can attend in the designated slots below and then submit their registration task. Students must log in to their PeopleSoft student portal to receive the registration link. They then complete their registration task via one of two methods, either "Programme Enrolment" which is an online rules-based system, or "Blank Shopping Cart" which is an online method of choosing courses which are then approved by an advisor and Dean. Detailed instructions will be provided. Students are allocated to certain days and times for advice as per the detailed programme below.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

- Please note that registration is an official activity in the academic calendar and students requiring advice are obliged to attend in their scheduled slot. The registration task should be submitted on the same day to avoid backlogs.
- Students attempting to obtain advice outside their scheduled timeslot without permission will not be accommodated.
- A late registration fee of R2000 will automatically be charged to the account of any student who registers late. Waiver of the fee will be considered by the Dean only in the most exceptional of circumstances which must be fully motivated in writing.
- All new International and SADC students must get fee clearance, present their study permits and health insurance details the day before they are scheduled to register at the IAPO office, Masingene Building, Middle Campus;

NEW STUDENTS

- All new students are to attend the advice sessions after attending the Orientation programme; BRING A PEN, YOUR ID AND OFFER LETTER as well as a copy of your SCHOOL LEAVING RESULTS.

RETURNING STUDENTS

- Returning students and transferring students must bring printouts of their academic record to in-person advice sessions.
