Students must log in to their PeopleSoft student portal to receive the registration link. They then complete their registration task via one of two methods, either "Programme Enrolment" which is an online rules-based system, or "Blank Shopping Cart" which is an online method of choosing courses which are then approved by an advisor and Dean. Detailed instructions will be provided. Students are allocated to certain days and times for advice as per the detailed programme below.
