- Minimum 65% academic aggregate
- South African citizen

- BSc Food Science/Diploma in Culinary Studies
- Minimum 60% academic aggregate
- Students in 2nd to 4th academic year
- South African citizen
- 27 years old and younger

- BCom in Logistics Management/BSc Operational Research
- Minimum 60% academic aggregate
- Students in 2nd to 3rd academic year
- South African citizen
- 27 years old and younger

Criminology
