




Donations for Research Activities

A donation is a charitable gift received by the University and may take the form of cash or assets. Donors often provide donations to support research activities. These donations are usually **unrestricted**, meaning they may be used for any purpose or project, with the expectation that the recipient (in this case, UCT's PI) will honour the broad purpose of the donation. In some instances, the donor may stipulate that the funds be used for a specific purpose, in which case the donation is referred to as a **restricted** donation.
