The <u>Wellcome Discovery</u> Awards scheme is soliciting applications from established researchers and teams from any discipline who want to pursue bold and creative research ideas to deliver significant shifts in understanding that could improve human life, health and wellbeing.

Research proposals can be in any discipline – including science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM), experimental medicine, humanities and social science, clinical/allied health sciences, and public health – as long as it has the potential to improve human life, health and wellbeing, and aligns with the Wellcome Trust <u>funding remit</u>.

Eligibility:

The call is open to established researchers who want to pursue bold and creative research ideas. You must aim to make a major contribution to your research field by:

- o generating significant shifts in understanding and/or
- developing methodologies, conceptual frameworks, tools or techniques that could benefit health-related research.

Award details:

- Grants are available for up to eight years.
- Lead applicants must be able to:
 - o demonstrate that they can drive and lead a substantial collaborative research programme.
 - o contribute at least 20% of their research time to the programme.

Deadlines and submission process:

This proposal requires the PI to complete an online application on the funder portal (<u>Wellcome Funding platform</u>) as well as requesting institutional approval via UCT's electronic Research Administration (eRA) system, prior to submission of the application.

Important: The call has 3 submission rounds per year, with deadlines in March, July & November.
